Dear Resident,

As you know, the water systems at Stadium Place have been treated to address the presence of Legionella, the bacterium that causes Legionnaire's disease.

Section 13 of your lease requires you to give notice if you intend to have an extended absence from your apartment of greater than seven days. We know Legionella prefers stagnant water. Therefore, it is critical to let the property manager know if you plan to be out of your apartment for more than seven days. By notifying management of your anticipated absence, we will be able to take the appropriate steps to ensure the water supply remains safe.

As a general reminder, if you experience symptoms of pneumonia, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, please contact your health care provider and inform him or her that you live in a location where some residents have been diagnosed with Legionnaire's Disease.
