Dear Stadium Place Residents,

As you know, we have been treating the water supply at Stadium Place to address the possibility of Legionella bacteria in the buildings. We have been taking proactive measures including chlorinating and superheating the water in all four Stadium Place apartment buildings. When we started the treatments to your water we distributed bottled water, and we have more available. Please let us know if you need some. **Until further notice, the Baltimore City Health Department is advising residents to continue taking the same precautions outlined in the attached letter, which you received on October 20th.**

Additionally, since it can take several days or longer after exposure to Legionella to become sick, please continue to report any symptoms to your health care provider.

If you are feeling ill, please contact your health care provider immediately and inform him or her that you live in a location where some residents have been diagnosed with Legionnaires' disease.
