Dear Residents:

We previously told you that we set the hot water temperature high in each apartment in our ongoing effort to keep the water systems safe at Stadium Place. We have been testing the temperatures and adjusting them as needed. While we had hoped to finish this work by Thursday, it has taken longer than expected. So we will be entering your apartment on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday for this purpose. You do not need to be present, though you may choose to be there.

**PLEASE BE CAREFUL:
The hot water temperature will be 130^o F.**

It is important to be cautious when using the water, as it is much hotter than usual and could cause scalding unless you mix it with sufficient cold water. It is recommended that you turn on the cold water first, then add hot water to reach the temperature that you like. We previously posted a "Scalding Alert" in your apartment when we turned up the temperature, and we will replace it if it is no longer posted.

The water temperature will remain at this higher temperature for the immediate future. If you are not comfortable with this temperature, please notify the management office right away.
